Create a Phone Tree

What is a phone tree? A phone tree is when a leader calls 4 or 5 people to remind them about voting. Each of those 5 people call their 4 or 5 people. Then those people call 5 more and so on.

Setup:

- Step #1:** Identify 5 people that you will be responsible to call and remind them to vote.
- Step #2:** Ask those 5 people to each find 5 people that they will recruit to do the same.
- Step #3:** Only if desired everyone in the phone tree turns in their name and numbers to the their lead. That lead turns it into their lead.

Action #1: Ballots out

- Step #1:** Leader calls their 5 and notifies ballots are out and instructs them to call their five.
- Step #2:** Those 5 call their 5 to remind them ballots are out
- Step #3:** Those 5 call their 5 to remind them ballots are out

Action #2: Any questions and Did you complete your ballot?

- Step #1:** Leader calls their 5 checks to ensure ballot was completed and turned in
- Step #2:** Those 5 call their 5 to remind them complete and turn in their ballot
- Step #3:** Those 5 call their 5 to remind them complete and turn in their ballot

Action #3: Did you turn in your ballot?

- Step #1:** Leader calls their 5 and asks is your ballot turned in and instructs them to call their five.
- Step #2:** Those 5 call their 5 check to ensure ballots are turned in.
- Step #3:** Those 5 call their 5 check to ensure ballots are turned in.
